to us directed we the subscribers as commissioners named in
the decree have proceeded to value the slaves left by the last will
and testament of Samuel Carter dec'd to be divided between
Edward A Carter and Fanny et Mullan, Edward M. Mullan
and Margaret A Mullan infants children of Dr John P
Mullan and having valued all the slaves so particularly
divided to the sum of ten thousand seven hundred and
thirty five dollars did proceed to divide them into two
lots as follows - Lot No 1 containing the following slaves viz
Asplum \$500 - Monroe \$500 Ned \$450 Jim \$425 Enoch \$350
Matt \$350 Davy \$350 Polly \$300 Phoebe \$300 Margaret \$250
Fanny \$300 Ally \$150 Cal \$125 Sarah \$125 Abram \$300
Hansley \$400 Nancy \$160 also two old negroes Rachael
and Tony. Lot No 2 as follows viz Oliver \$500 Moses \$450
Hall \$450 Harry \$425 George 375 Isham \$350 Dugan \$350
Joe \$350 Sucinda \$300 Dick \$250 Celia \$200 Myra \$175
Venny \$150 Douglass \$100 Tom \$400 Daniel \$425 old Asplum
\$150 also two old negroes Bob and Ben and the
said Edward A Carter having permitted the said John
A Mullan as guardian of his infants children to have
choice of lots and he having chosen lot No 2 Valued
at \$5400 and to pay \$32⁵⁰ to lot No 1 and the said
commissioners having acquiesced in the said agreement -
