REVOLUTION NEWSLETTER'

One important component of the President General's Project addresses needed upgrades to our beautiful Headquarters. During the winter, the cooling tower and pump system were replaced, providing greater temperature control as well as energy savings. Project funds also made possible the installation of high-speed fiber optic cable to expand our Internet bandwidth, thereby allowing improved online access to GRS records by staff and the many volunteers who assist prospective members with application papers. We also will be able to utilize more webinars and videos for leadership training and membership recruitment. One other exciting enhancement is the installation of solar panels on the roof of Constitution Hall. This is a major investment not only in our building but also in the future. The estimated savings over the panels' 30-year life span is \$1 million.

March is Women's History Month, and I know you will enjoy the stories in this issue of American Spirit. Each article features strong women, just like the ones who built our magnificent Society.
