INTRODUCTION

This book contains land entries in the western portion of the original Brunswick County, namely, Malifax, Fittsylvania, Benry, Franklin, and Patrick. The area concerned was south of the Roanoke-Staunton River, west of Tewahomony Creek (now Aaron's Creek which divides Mecklenburg and Malifax counties), and extending to the Blue Ridge Mountains. These counties were formed from Lumenburg, which was separated from Brunswick in 1746.

In 1723, the Lords of Trade of London, upon the patition of the Virginia Council, exempted the inhabitants of Brunswick from the payment of quit rents and the purchase of land rights for seven years. In the same Order, the Crown limited these land grants to 1000 acres per person. This was to encourage actual settlers along the frontier. This policy was later changed and larger grants were permitted, but the principle was maintained in requiring three out of every fifty acres to be cultivated, or three head of cattle to be maintained, or a house of certain dimensions to be built.

Brunswick County's western lands developed slowly. In order to encourage settlement along the Rochoke River, in November 1730, taxfree status for a period of ten years was offered to settlers who would brave the dangers of the wilderness and make their homes there. These inducements attracted Swiss immigrants and the Germans, Quakers, and Scotch-Irish who were then moving in great numbers from Pennsylvania. The men who sat in executive council in Williamsburg issued Orders of Council for thousands of acres for themselves. Also, the men of eastern Brunswick and adjacent counties secured many Orders of Council for various size holdings.

It must be pointed out that an entry for land was but a statement of intention. Ownership of land resulted from satisfying the requirements for settlement on the land and improving it. For this reason many entries were voided. Nevertheless, it is surprising how many of the families found in the area today are those who first settled here. Interwoven in this book is a story of courage and high adventure. It is of both genealogical and historical importance. Many evidences of the Indians who once lived here can still be found along the streams and river banks after heavy rains and flooding.

This Entry Book has been transcribed verbatim from a photographic copy of the original book which is in the Clerk's Office at the Pittsylvania County Courthouse, Chatham, Virginia. Marginal notes are shown in parentheses before the entry. Words added in a different handwriting are enclosed in /slashes/. One name in particular, added over an illegible blot on page 10, could have been more accurately interpreted as Drury Stith, Buckner Stith and Thos. Duggins, not Drury, John, Buckner Stith & Thos. Duggins. I have underlined a letter or word when in doubt. In general, the entries are legible. Rowever, the usual problem of S & L and I & J existed, t was not crossed, a left open, and u interchangeable with double e, initial letters of proper names were not always capitalized. Spellings of names were compared with other contemporary records. Yet, some errors in judgment may have been made.

It is obvious that several people wrote in the entry book because of differences in style of handwriting, punctuation, spelling, etc. I have been able to identify only John Donelson and William Hale. Some took the liberty of abbreviating even surnames.
