that sum putton was so that I can dont please to
deaple them horses I ma cum back again and
want them we have a party that it is sup sum times
we here at the same place yet keep talking about leaving
going down river washington city great talk of a fall down
that I dont seem to excite us much we here canon firing
yesterday had not heard from them yet dice hall is better
more walk her and the make on wilson Stokes is very
bad indeed hard with while for to site for us to cum home
for we cant get a well fur low now our Captor cant
get one for he self dont think he has men over him I think
men can get fur low we will cum as sum as we can
I have as munny as I can to a march at this
time I will want sum here by God after a while I will
rite when you get the cloth ready how to cut them
out R. P. Gregory went to the junction today to get his box
while he was gone a nuther wagon broke the box
it had one bucket with sum potatoes Sage Salt Cray bread to live
Great too heads cabbage peaches was spill and spill the
bread most of it and ~~the~~ the bread all was good
but them dont send no more peaches I was in hope of some
munny we was glad to get the box with a plenty
of salt here I have not heard from John S Ganes yet
I would be glad to hear from him now

farther you mus get Michm T to hal your blatt
to Conchley for we cant swim we a plast tubar
meanz thousands is plast we hope we wil see
we god than if we had staid at home we mus not
give you take every thing away and for i hope we
all wil turn home after a while of all that turn
to all these nothing now take at present you must
not sume as you get this I will like to see my little
Cath Gals ~~the~~ John R. Green to be a good boy tel
papi gets home of ~~the~~ Gregory of Martha of Gregory
