With the Reynolds and Miller Bibles is a small Bible of the Poague family. All of the above Bibles are the property of the granddaughter of Mattie Snider, in Natural Bridge, Virginia. The Poagues migrated into Rockbridge from Augusta County, Virginia.

Wood Family Bible

The title page of this Bible is missing. The Bible is still in the hands of the Wood family of Clifton Forge, Virginia, descendants of the brother of Joseph Wood of Winchester who deeded the Botetourt lands to his brother James Wood named in this Bible.

Elizabeth Crenshaw Davis was born July 20, 1796, wife of James Wood.

Rev. Davis Morton Wood was born Sept. 10, 1819 and died 1904, Nov. 9

Rev. Davis Morton Wood married Sabrina Payne, dau. of Lewis & Louisa Payne.

Written on the bottom of the entries is "James H. Wood was given this ground by his father James Wood who was given this land by his father Joseph Wood one of the founders of Winchester." (n.b. Deeds of Frederick County show that Joseph Wood of Winchester deeded lands in Botetourt to his brother James Wood.

(note: Numerous obituaries from Lexington Gazette was pasted on the back pages of the Miller Bible. One of interest is as follows: "At Paris, France, Mary McDowell, third dau. of the late Elizabeth Lovejoy McDowell (sometime Beandt) and Joseph McDowell, Esq. of Lexington area, Dec. 2, 1875."

"Died on Mar. 11, 1863, Alice, ae. 11 yrs. and Frank ae. 2, children of Capt. James G. Updike of this county of scarlet fever, and their mother preceeded them by a few short months."

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
