J. Carter on or before Decr 19th 1893; and bond of same parties for - eighty dollars dated Sept 8th 1893 payable to said Geo. J. Carter on or before October 1st 1894 with interest from date.

① This deed made this the 21st day of September 1893 between G. W. Dance, J. W. Dance, C. H. Dance and W. H. Dance of the one part and C. C. Carrington of the other part - Witnesseth that the said G. W. Dance, J. W. Dance, C. H. Dance and W. H. Dance do grant convey and transfer to the said C. C. Carrington all their crops of Tobacco cultivated made and raised by them in the present year 1893 both that now growing and that which has been cut from the land, the crops of the said C. H. Dance and W. H. Dance being on their land situated in Halifax County Va. adjoining the lands of A. A. Farmer the lands formerly owned by W. W. Breedlove and others, the crops of the said G. W. Dance and J. W. Dance heretofore -
