To The Worshipful Justices of the County Court
of Halifax County in Chancery sitting
Humbly Complaining sheweth unto your
worships your orators Albert Satterfield
William Satterfield & Geo W Satterfield
that their father Samuel Satterfield
died in the County of Halifax in the
year 1841 having first made & published
his last will & testament which was
duly admitted to record in the County
Court of Halifax at the February term
1841 a copy of which will is herewith
exhibited as a part of this Bill by which
it will appear that the said Samuel
Satterfield left to his wife one third
of his estate for during her life &
at her death to be divided between
his four children namely Geo
Satterfield Isaac Satterfield Albert
Satterfield William Satterfield & Geo
W Satterfield. Your orators charge that
a tract of land containing about one
hundred acres on the head waters of
Evans Creek was assigned to the
widow of the said Satterfield to be
held by her during her life your
orators charge that the wife of the
said Samuel Satterfield is now
dead & the land aforesaid is now
subject to division according to the
will of the said Samuel Satterfield. They
charge that the same can not be divided
in kind and that it will be greatly to the
interest of all parties concerned for

the same to be said & the proceeds divided
they charge that Geo Satterfield is now
dead & left one child named Latha
Satterfield that the said Isaac Satterfield
is also dead & left children in North
Carolina whose names are unknown
your action being without remedy in
a County Law we advised to apply to
this Honorable Court for relief to that
end they pray that the said Latha
Satterfield & the children of Isaac Satterfield
whose names are unknown may
be made parties to this Bill & require
to answer the same may the Court
direct the said Latha to be sold &
grant the Com in execution hereto of Spe
