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Lewis a slave who stands committed to the jail of this county that he may be  
was brought into court by the jailer & on the motion of the attorney for the Commonwealth the following charge was  
made by the court for a felony by him committed <sup>the property of the jailer did in the night of</sup> the 26<sup>th</sup> day of Nov<sup>r</sup> 1859 in said County feloniously and burglariously break &  
enter the store house of Ramsey, Wetherill & Co in said County and did feloniously  
take, steal and carry away from the said Ramsey, Wetherill & Co several over coats  
& drap coats, 2 quilting shawls - about 6 ladies shawls. hats - boots and shoes  
a lot of ladies drap goods and various other articles of the value off from them to five  
hundred Dollars - whereupon  
the court assigned Hugh Dillard Counsel for the said slave & on his motion the proce-  
dure is continued till the next term.

In Chancery. This day this cause came only consent of  
Sarah Reynolds &c. to be heard upon the bill of the complainant. The separate answer  
of Sarah Reynolds, the joint answer of the other Defendants the replications thereto  
to the exhibits & was argued by counsel: On consideration whereof the court doth  
adjudge order & decree that there be a commission of three persons who are hereby appointed special  
commissioners for that purpose, do proceed with the assistance of competent surveyors if  
necessary to divide & apportion to Sarah Reynolds one equal third part of the land in the  
Bill mentioned to be held by her during her life as for her dower of the land of  
her deceased husband John D. Reynolds & that they proceed to make partition  
of the residue of said lands if they find that the same can be conveniently  
done without material prejudice to the interests of the parties, and in making  
such partition they are directed to allot one ninth part to Hugh Reynolds, an  
ninth part to John P. Reynolds in and the remaining portion of such residue  
being 2/3 of the same to the said John P. Reynolds the purchaser of the respec-  
tive shares of Thomas Adams Sally Hedrick John Reynolds Charles Reynolds  
Joseph Reynolds & Allen Reynolds. And the said Courts are directed to refer  
their proceedings to the court. But if the said special Courts shall ascertain  
that partition of said residue cannot be conveniently & judiciously made as afo-  
resaid then the said Hugh Reynolds who is hereby appointed a special com-  
missioner for that purpose is directed to sell the said residue of lands at public auction  
after reasonable advertisement on a credit of six and twelve months taking  
bond with good security from the purchaser and make report of the  
same to the court in order to a further decree.
